

ROCK RAKE AVAILABLE FOR USE IN ORLEANS COUNTY

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- The Degelman RR150 Rock Rake is available to assist with rock removal, gravel reclamation, and site preparation.
- This equipment is intended to support conservation crop rotation and farm viability by assisting with rock management, field preparation, and soil surface improvement needed to maintain productive agricultural land.

**The Orleans County Conservation District has one Rock Rake for rent.
Rented on a first come first serve basis at a rate of \$17/ac.**

- The rock rake can be used for rock windrowing, gravel reclamation, field preparation, and leveling project sites.
- Tractor requirements: minimum **75 HP**, equipped with **540 or 1000 RPM PTO**, and hydraulic flow of **at least 17 GPM** at 2,700 psi, with an **ideal range of 20–30 GPM** at 3,000 psi.
- The rock rake has a **14 ft working width, 14 ft drum length, and 10 inches of ground clearance.**
- Transport width is **7 ft 4 inches**, and transport length is **18 ft 10 inches.**
- Hitch weight required is **475 lbs.**
- A signed rental agreement and \$100 deposit is required prior to equipment use.
- It is the responsibility of the renter to transport the rock rake.
- It is the farmer's responsibility to properly operate and maintain the equipment, and to address any preventable damage and repairs.
- OCNRCD can also provide support in identifying and accessing grant resources related to crop rotation and other associated conservation practices.
